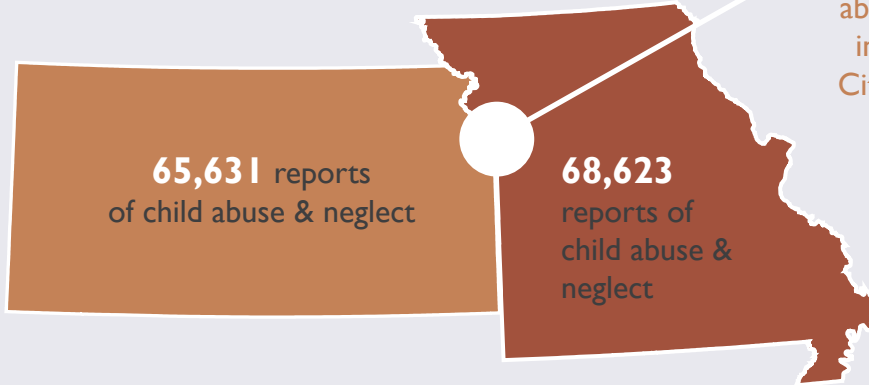

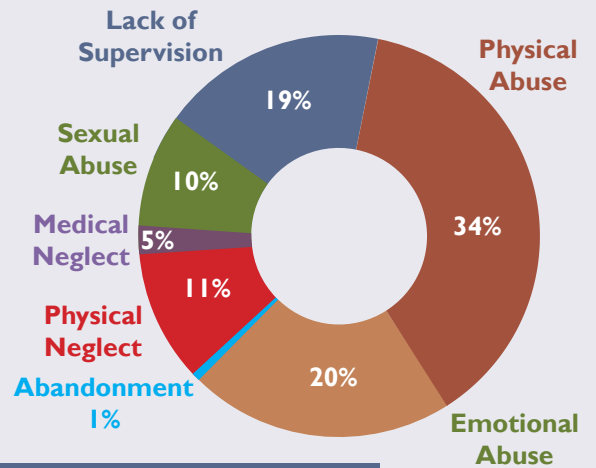
## 2015 Cases of Abuse (June - July)



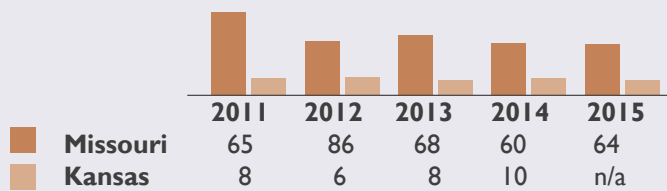
## Types of Abuse

Physical abuse accounts for the largest percentage of the cases of abuse, after which the most common types are emotional abuse, lack of supervision, and sexual abuse. Physical and medical neglect and abandonment are lesser, but also significant forms of abuse to which children are subjected.

## Child Fatalities Due to Abuse or Neglect



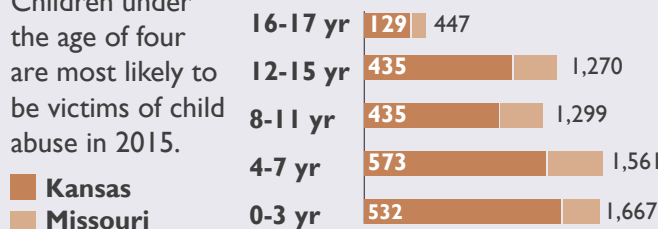
Child fatalities that have resulted from abuse or neglect have fluctuated over the past five years. These numbers only reflect the deaths that were reported.



A child is abused or neglected every 47 seconds in the U.S.
